## Remembering N8M: 1967

\*102 Teams played 8-Man football in 1967- down 38 from the previous year due to both school consolidations and school closings\*

200 pound linemen were not wide-spread in Nebraska in the 1960s, but this all state squad included Venango's 6-4, 240 pound *Gerald Strand*, who was joined by *Bill Kuester* of Elgin and Center *Joe Knox* of Maywood- who checked in at 190 and 185 respectively. This interior line trio would be the largest in the history of the 8-Man all state team (to that point).

The all state backfield was paced by a sensational athlete from the Nebraska School for the Deaf named *Ken Eurek*. Eurek, an Arcadia native, was named to a Junior National Deaf All-American team in 1966, and quarterbacked his team to an 8-0 record in 1967 while running for 24 touchdowns and passing for another 13.

**Dave Bohlken** from Talmage, the Class D 220-yard dash champion at the 1967 State Track Meet, rushed for 844 yards and 25 touchdowns on 113 carries.

The all-state backfield was topped off by *Chris Krause* of 8-Man Champion Madrid Wheatland. Krause was the most spectacular Dual-Threat Quarterback of his day, rushing for 1,710 yards and passing for an additional 1,271 yards. He also averaged 11 stops a game from his linebacker slot.

Lewiston's *Ron Tegtmeier* also had a banner campaign as a receiver, accumulating 737 yards and hauling in 18 touchdown receptions.
