Ansley, NE- Leigh took advantage of three Ansley turnovers in the first half, then coasted to a 36-8 victory. The blue and white clad Panthers converted an opening quarter interception into a 7-0 lead after 1,000 yard rusher Shane Belohrad bulled in from a yard out. Leigh also scored twice in the second quarter on short field drives of 35 and 25 yards after recovering two Ansley fumbles.

Leigh QB Dan Gall (who kicked a 22-yard field goal with six seconds left in the semifinal to beat Nebraska Christian 3-0) sprinted 12 yards for the first touchdown of the second quarter and then Belohrad crashed in again from a yard out to give Leigh a commanding 28-0 lead. Ansley's John Slack then hit Dana Thompson for a 1 yard score as the Warriors closed it to 28-6 at the half.

The Panthers accumulated 249 yards rushing in the game. Belohrad ended the night with 135 yards on 39 carries with scoring runs of 1, 1 and 5 yards. The All-State RB also hauled in four passes for 40 yards from Gall. The stingy Leigh defense also limited Ansley to 113 total yards and 8 first downs in the game. Leigh completed the season with a perfect 12-0 record and their first state football championship since winning the 1952 Six-Man title.

Greeley's air circus, led by All-State quarterback Rich Mlinar, that matched up against Giltner's ball hawking defense. Mlinar, who had been intercepted only three times coming in the previous 12 games, was picked off exactly 3 times in the championship, twice by the pirating Les Cates and once by Randy Findley in Giltner's 34-22 victory.

Greeley hit the board first in the opening stanza when Larry Wood intercepted a Findlay pass and raced 29 yards for the score. The Hornets responded quickly as Cates then bolted in from 4 yards away to open the second quarter. Findlay then capped a 48 yard drive by sweeping in for a Giltner score from 8 yards out. Two minutes later, thousand yard rusher David LaBrie scooted 54 yards for another score before Randy Findley added a 3 yard touchdown run. The 28 point second quarter outburst by the Hornets gave them a 28-6 halftime advantage.

The Bulldogs were still in it as they took the second half kick and marched for a score when Mlinar hit Gary Murphy for an 8 yard TD strike. Greeley was set to mount another drive in the 4th but Cates stepped in front of a Bulldog receiver to post a 15 yard Pick 6, giving the Hornets a 34-14 lead. Greeley's Doug Sorensen then returned the ensuing Giltner kickoff 75 yards for a score, pulling the team to within 34-22. The Bulldog defense then held Giltner on downs with 2:46 left in the game, but forty five seconds later Randy Gartner recovered a Greeley fumble to seal the win, capping a perfect 13-0 record.
